[Rule 5] VACCINATION

All cats and kittens of the appropriate age to be vaccinated against feline enteritis and feline respiratory diseases – the final effective injection for a kitten being given at not less than twelve (12) weeks of age and prior to showing. It will be necessary to produce certificates for all kittens. (*Nov 2018, Jan 2019*)

[Rule 7] All exhibits must have all claws trimmed (meaning removal of sharp tip only)



[Rule 8.1] VETTING

Exhibits must be present at vetting at the advertised times for veterinary inspection. Exhibits arriving later than the advertised vetting time may be refused entry. (*Jan 2019*)

[Rule 17.1] UNABLE TO BE VETTED

A cat or kitten which because of its demeanour cannot be examined by a Vet during vetting will be deemed to be UTV (Unable to be Vetted), and must be removed from the venue.

[Rule 17.2] UNABLE TO BE JUDGED

A cat or kitten that is unable to be taken from the cage to the judging table or handled sufficiently to be judged is to be deemed UTJ (Unable to be Judged) and no award is to be made. This is effective in that ring only, with no cumulative effect towards disqualification. Two (2) recorded offences within twelve (12) months from the 1st offence will mean the cat must be rested for two (2) calendar months. If a cat is rested and then reoffends once, it will not be permitted to be shown again. (*Nov 2018*)

[Rule 17.3] UNABLE TO BE HANDLED

A cat or kitten which acts in a very aggressive manner or bites or lacerates a Judge, Handler, Steward or Vet during vetting or judging will be deemed UTH (Unable to be Handled).

Handler to report to GC Representative. GC Representative to discuss incident with reporting person and any witnesses, and determine whether the cat or kitten is to be considered aggressive. A written report of any incident will be filed with GC Secretary.

If UTH for judging or vetting and deemed to be acting aggressively, the cat will be banned for life.

The GC Representative and Show Manager MUST be informed when ANY person is bitten or lacerated by ANY cat or kitten at ANY show.
