ELIGIBILITY

Only GCCFSA current members who have GCCFSA registered prefixes can be listed.

BREED HEADINGS

WILL BE USED FOR THE DIRECTORY, NOT COLOURS.

STANDARD LISTING: Prefix, name of breeder, suburb, postcode, and phone number / mobile. Street (and number) will not be shown.

EXTRA LINES will be permitted again, at a cost of \$3.00 for each additional line in each listing. Breeders have asked for the opportunity to include information such as an additional telephone number, colour of cats bred (mainly if specialising in one colour). Country exhibitors who are willing to deliver kittens to Adelaide have asked to be allowed to advertise this. Several Veterinarians have asked for information on colours, so they can refer clients to appropriate breeders. Samples of extra lines can be seen in previous issues.

ORDER OF LISTINGS:

Breeds as shown in "ACF BREED STANDARDS" will be listed in Groups, in alphabetical order, and catteries listed alphabetically under relevant breed headings.

APPLICATION FOR INCLUSION IN DIRECTORY MUST BE ON THE FORM BELOW.

"DIRECTORY" CIRCULATION & DISTRIBUTION:

The Directory will be at Adelaide Royal Show and all GCCFSA cat shows. Copies are given to interested Vets and local Councils by members, and to organisers of functions such as pet promotions. They are sent to prospective purchasers on request, and are available to anyone willing or able to assist with distribution and circulation. The Directory is also available on the GCCFSA website.

Changes to information during year can be made to web site only.

BREEDERS ADVERTISING IN DIRECTORY MUST ABIDE BY GCCFSA CODE OF ETHICS (SEE OVER)

All must also abide by SA Government legislation regarding breeders and owners (when it comes in.)

"Late Entry" is available for web only, at same prices. Also additional lines for web during year, same price.

CODE OF ETHICS FOR BREEDERS / OWNERS

1. Breeders breed with the intention of improving the standard of *his chosen breed, and not for commercial purposes.
2. All litters and kittens of a litter should be registered with the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy of S.A. Inc.
3. Not knowingly sell or transfer from *his care, any cat/kitten to commercial wholesalers, retail pet dealers, or directly or indirectly allow a cat/kitten to be given as a prize or donation in a contest of any kind.
4. The cat/kitten shall be in the best possible condition and health before it goes to a new home.
5. Cats and kittens should be handled sufficiently to be well socialized.
6. No kitten should be sold at less than twelve (12) weeks of age.
7. As far as possible it should be free from internal and external parasites.
8. The cat/kitten should be immunised against Feline Infection Enteritis and Feline Respiratory Diseases - the final effective Feline Infectious Enteritis injection for a kitten being given at not less than twelve (12) weeks of age.
9. All breeding cats shall be tested for known heritable defects.
10. Transfer of a cat/kitten must be effected within 3 months of gift or sale to a new owner. This is the responsibility of the Breeder.
11. Transfer may be made for "Breeding" or "Non-Breeding". "Non-Breeding" means that should the cat produce kittens, none of its progeny can be registered, the cat is meant to be desexed. It is the responsibility of the breeder to explain to the new owner the meaning of "Non-Breeding" status.
12. Furnish the new owner with details of diet, and any information that will ensure the cat/kitten fits into its new environment with minimum stress.
13. Ensure that the purchaser of a stud male is made fully aware of the care, responsibility and the standard of facilities required to keep such a cat.
14. Will not permit matings between registered and unregistered animals.

All breeders advertising in the Directory agree that they will follow the above code.

All will also be bound by any Changes to the Dog & Cat Management Act and any Government Legislation that may be introduced if applicable. You will be kept informed of developments through GC Clubs and our web site.
