Tandanya, formed in July 1976, is an “all breeds” cat club. Membership is open to all cat owners and people interested in cats. We cater for lovers of all breeds of pedigreed cats and unpedigreed or domestic cats. Tandanya's Club Membership fees are very reasonable and are shown on Membership application form in this show catalogue. Special reduced fees apply to Families and Junior (under 16) members, and all adult financial Club Members enjoy the same rights and privileges.

New members are always welcome.

Meetings held every 6-8 weeks, in January, March, May, July, September and November, usually on Sunday when there's no show. At present, General Meetings are held in Secretary's home at Glanville. AGM is in November (2005: Sunday 30th).

Committee Meetings may be held in “in-between” months. A copy of the minutes is given to every member present at the following General Meeting.

Except when extreme urgency arises, all business of the Club is handled at TCC Committee and/or General Meetings. Members are encouraged to take

an active interest in all Club affairs.

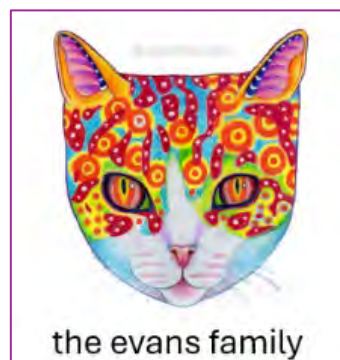

WHO was John Evans? (repeating from our last show, mostly condensed from the 2016 ACF Yearbook):

Henry John Evans was known to all as John. Early in 1963 he met Eleanor Button, whom he “renamed” Nell, and they married on 9 November that year. They were together and inseparable until John's death on 29 November 2015. They had two daughters, Tiffany and Linda. One of John's proudest moments was when Linda produced his only grandchild in 2001. He was there to welcome Tariq into the world, and he cut the cord. Then began a new learning curve — a very easy and pleasurable one — how to be, according to Tariq, “the best grandad in the world”. John adored Tariq and was so proud of him and his achievements.

In 1974, John and Nell fulfilled her childhood dream of owning a Persian cat. They bought Felicia, a blue Persian, with “breeding rights”. They had no idea what changes she would bring to their lives. They bred many kittens and loved their involvement with the felines, but John really showed how capable he was in the cat fancy. He ran shows without losing his cool and became a registrar for the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy of South Australia, learning to use computer technology and working out some of the intricacies of genetic possibilities. He also took on the foundation of the registry of Cats Victoria Inc. which he passed on to a successor last year.

In the years that followed John accompanied Nell to every National Cat Show and supported Nell in her role of Honorary Secretary of the Australian Cat Federation (as well as both having a role in the SA Cat Fancy). They visited every State in Australia and John made many friends at these events. He used to say he went just so Nell could use his baggage allowance and so he could carry her bags. At every national show, until last year, he helped with the physical work that had to be done and was always ready to do anything he could to help anyone, even if it was only giving a smile or a hug when needed.

John was almost always unruffled, and was a calming influence on those around him. He had a knack of knowing what was needed, whether it was a job to be done or a hug to be given at the right moment. In August 2014 he was diagnosed with cholangiocarcinoma. He took it in his stride when the prognosis was that it was inoperable, terminal but he was not expected to die within 12 months. John had six cycles of chemotherapy without any of the expected side effects. He and the family continued to live a normal life and he made his usual trip to the National Cat Show in Perth with Nell. Unfortunately, he had unknowingly developed an ulcer that began to bleed. He suffered severe fluid build-up and, despite ongoing medical intervention, the poisons that had built up in his blood determined the outcome, and on Friday 27 November he went home by ambulance to do what he had hoped from that first diagnosis would be possible. would be possible . . . to die at home.

The Australian cat fancy will miss John greatly.

Footnote, nearly six years on, because one can't think of everything when writing an obituary, from which the above was extracted): There was little that John could not or would not do. His spent many years in aeromodelling, loved camping (at Port Hughes preferably), was a keen fisherman and boatie, turned his hand to demolition, construction painting, concreting, was a great mechanic, an aircraft airframe engineer (and rebuilt a Tiger Moth), avid reader, competitive square dancer, gardener, had the most amazing sense of wry humour and was the most compassionate and helpful gentleman any of us knew and loved.

Nell was a trouper.

And indeed, she served ACF with a singularity of purpose. She never sought the spotlight – indeed, she shied away from it – but she could be found busy in the ACF's "boiler room", invariably with her John helping out. I recall (typical Nell!) her ironing of envelopes containing bulky paperwork for Executive or affiliates to ensure they fitted through the Auspost slot thus avoiding double the cost of postage for ACF!

Nell had a mind (and memory) like a steel trap as she frequently demonstrated at meetings, to the surprise of many who hadn't known her in her national Sec capacity. She and my then-husband, John Blythe (ACF President for 2 different terms) used to have their regular phone calls behind closed doors as they sorted out some incredibly serious issues for the good of ACF: there were some torrid times and I know John always sought and respected her opinion.

Proud mother of Tiff and Linda and pleased-as-punch grandmother to the apple of her eye, grandson Tariq, Nell Evans was a special breed of person who, in her quiet way, never wanted to be regarded as cat fancy elite, but wanted the best outcomes for her hobby; the cat fancy. Nell, you'll be missed. You ARE missed, and I'm sorry I didn't find that info you wanted a few weeks ago.

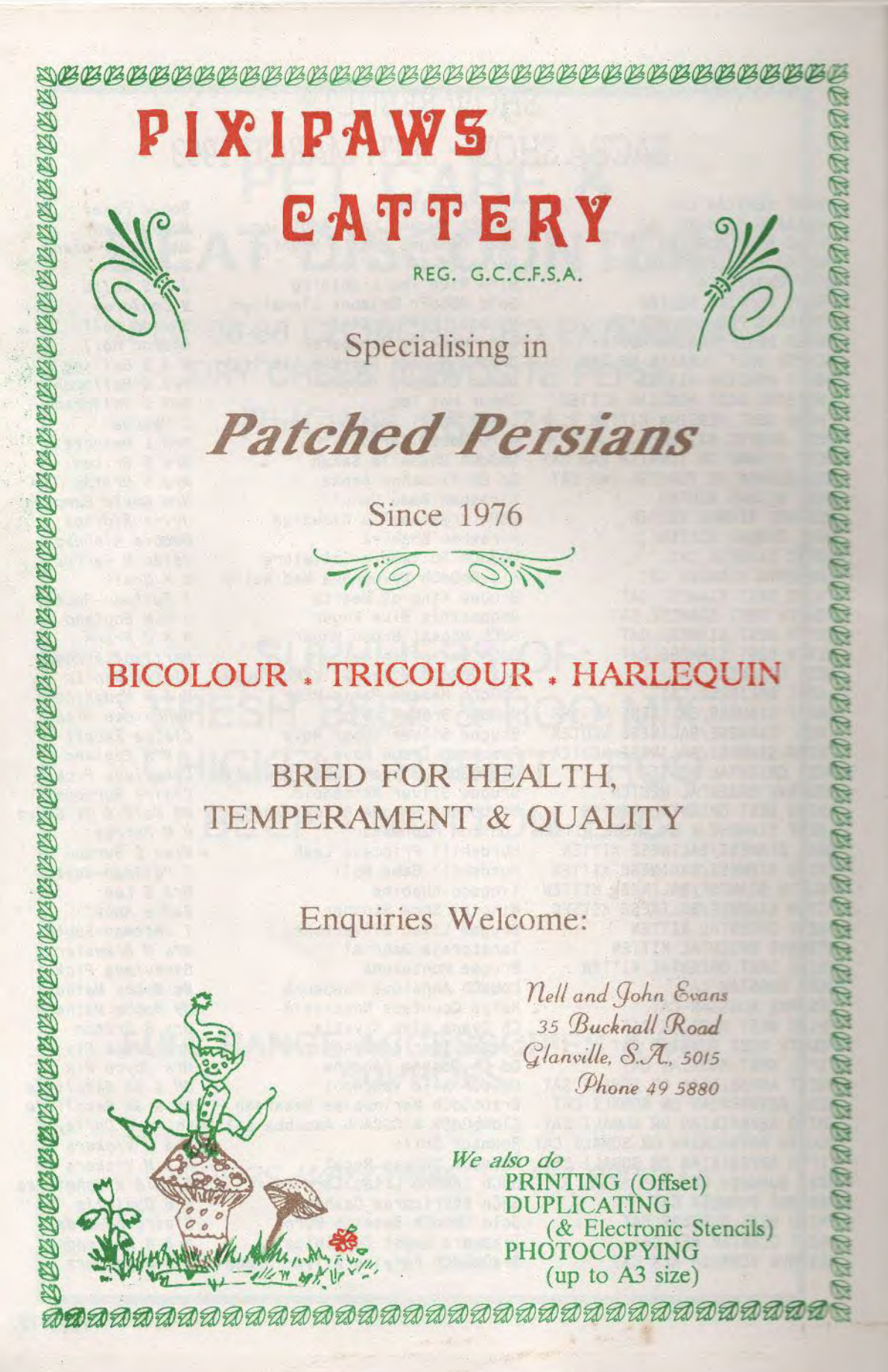

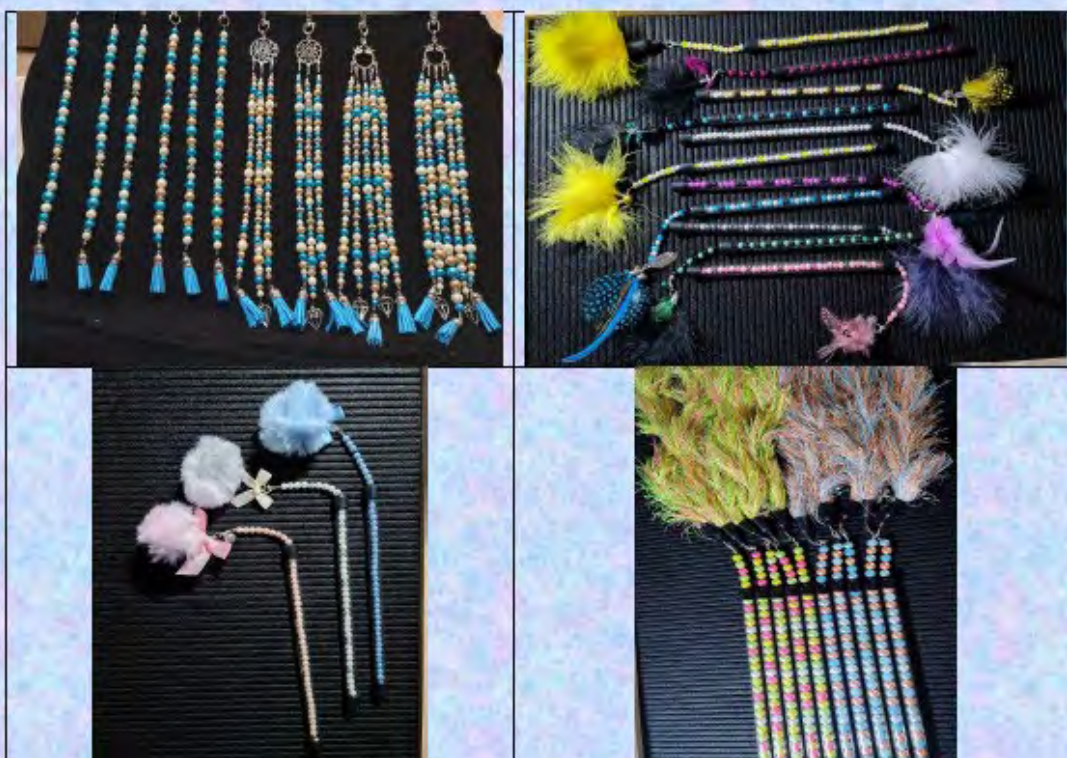
