Open Style Judging In Line Vetting EXHIBITS WILL BE REFUSED ENTRY AFTER 8.30AM



Any exhibit which shown and considered to be under sedation will be disqualified (8.10)

All exhibits to have ALL nails cut

At vetting in, any exhibit shall be rejected by the vet that's shows symptoms of, or may be suffering from, any contagious disease, has external parasites, is dirty and unfit for exhibition: or any male cat which is mon-orchid or any female obviously in kitten (8.2)

Exhibitors must provide a covered litter tray for each cat to avoid unnecessary odours in the hall. Tray MUST be covered and placed under the show cage.

Used litter trays are NOT to be emptied into any of the show garbage bags.

No exhibit shall be removed from the show prior to the close of the show with out permission of the show manager.

Scanning of microchips will take place in all kittens

Vaccinations Certificates MUST be provided at Vetting in for all kittens with 2 x F3 Vaccinations completed. Please ensure that kittens can be identified on the vaccination card and the original stickers and vet signature are available. NO PHONE PHOTOS

GCCFSA requires exhibitors to abide by the rules and code of ethics. Any issues must be dealt with on the day by the hosting club.

Please park you cars in the marked bays only

Show Management reserves the right to change the judging assignments depending on the number of entries.

Please not that the venue rules state NO SMOKING or CHEWING of Gum on the grounds. These rule will be reinforced.



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
