



- *ONLY hard copies of vaccination card/certificates will be accepted.*
- *Exhibitors must provide a covered litter tray for each cat.*
- *No exhibit shall be removed from the show prior to the close of the show without the prior permission of the show manager.*
- *Show management reserves the right to change the judging assignments.*
- *Please note: Venue rules state no smoking or chewing gum on the grounds.*
