Please note that there is to be no smoking or chewing gum on the premises. Conducted under the Rules and Regulations of GCCFSA. This show has an approved COVID-Safe Plan.

2021 GCCFSA COVID-SAFE GUIDELINES GCCFSA will:

- Follow the guidelines of SA Health at all times.
- Remind exhibitors to wear a mask in shared indoor public places (excluding relevant medical conditions).
- Provide QR code on entry or keep an attendance record, including the name, phone number or email
 address, and date and time of people attending the cat show, for the purpose of contact tracing in relation
 to COVID-19.
- Maintain and encourage others to maintain the physical distancing principle of at least 1.5 metres separation or the current principle, where possible:
 - o This includes between groups within each room.
 - o At entry and exit points.
- Consider venue layout and move tables and seating to comply with physical distancing and density requirements applicable at the time of the show.
- Display signage at the venue entrance to instruct members of the public (and staff) not to enter if they are unwell or have COVID-19 symptoms.
- Encourage and support downloading of COVID-Safe App.
- Clean bathrooms more frequently than lower traffic areas, especially taps, door handles and other frequently touched points.
- Provide hand-sanitiser on entry and exit of the premises.

Exhibitors will:

- Declare any contact with COVID-19 by completing the COVID-Safe Questionnaire with their entry, including the following statements:
 - o They do not have any symptoms at the time of entry
 - o They have not been to any hotspots within the previous 14 days
 - They have not been in close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the previous
 14 days
 - o They do not feel unwell at the time of entry.
- Wear a mask as per the current SA Heath guidelines (excluding relevant medical conditions).
- Practice safe hygiene by making use of the hand sanitiser provided by the show management, throughout the show.
- Practice physical distancing requirements where possible.
- Maintain physical distancing from judges and stewards at all times.
- Should an exhibitor become unwell with COVID-like symptoms prior to the show, it is important that they do not attend.
- Should an exhibitor become unwell with COVID-like symptoms during the show, it is important to advise show management immediately. You may be asked to leave the show hall and a COVID-19 test will be required to ensure the safety of all exhibitors.

QR Code to be read on entry, hand sanitiser use and social distancing to be observed. Masks are mandatory. COVID-Safe Plans are available for viewing on-site.
