

VACCINATION CERTIFICATES MUST NOW BE PROVIDED AT VETTING FOR ALL KITTENS. PLEASE ENSURE THAT KITTENS CAN BE IDENTIFIED ON THE VETTING CARD AND THE ORIGINAL STICKERS AND VET SIGNATURES ARE AVAILABLE.

EXHIBITORS MUST PROVIDE A COVERED LITTER TRAY FOR EACH CAT TO AVOID UNNECESSARY ODOURS IN THE HALL. NO EXHIBIT SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOW PRIOR TO THE CLOSE OF THE SHOW WITHOUT THE PRIOR PERMISSION OF THE SHOW MANAGER. ALL EXHIBITS MUST HAVE THEIR CLAWS TRIMMED. SHOW MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHANGE THE JUDGING ASSIGNMENTS DEPENDING ON THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES.

2022 GCCFSA COVID-SAFE GUIDELINES

GCCFSA will:

- Follow the guidelines of SA Health at all times.
- Remind exhibitors to wear a mask in shared indoor public places (excluding relevant medical conditions).
- Encourage attendees to maintain physical distancing principles or the current SA Health principle, where possible.
- Consider venue layout and move tables and seating to comply with physical distancing and density requirements applicable at the time of the show.
- Display signage at the venue entrance to instruct members of the public (and staff) not to enter if they are unwell or have COVID-19 symptoms.
- Encourage and support downloading of COVID-Safe App.
- Provide hand-sanitiser on entry and exit of the premises.

Exhibitors will:

- Wear a mask as per the current SA Health guidelines (excluding relevant medical conditions).
- Practice safe hygiene by making use of the hand sanitiser provided by the show management, throughout the show.
- Practice physical distancing requirements where possible.
- Maintain physical distancing from judges and stewards at all times.
- Should an exhibitor become unwell with COVID-like symptoms prior to the show, it is important that they do not attend.
- Should an exhibitor become unwell with COVID-like symptoms during the show, it is important to advise show management immediately. You will be asked to leave the show hall and a COVID-19 test will be required to ensure the safety of all exhibitors.

Hand sanitiser use and social distancing to be observed.

Masks are mandatory for shared indoor public places.

The Questionnaire is not currently required.
