#### IN-LINE VETTING WILL APPLY

Junior Exhibitors: Children aged between 5 and 18 years old can enter only one exhibit each. Juniors are responsible for checking in their cats and taking care of their exhibit and cage throughout the show.

**Kitten Vaccination:** All kittens participating in the show must have at least two vaccinations. Please ensure that the vetting card clearly identifies the kittens and contains original vaccination stickers and vet signatures.

Covered Litter Tray: Each exhibitor must provide a covered litter tray for their cat to prevent unnecessary odours in the hall.

Exhibit Removal: Exhibits cannot be removed from the show before its closure without prior permission from the show manager.

Claw Trimming: All exhibits must have their claws trimmed.

Judging Assignments: The show management reserves the right to change judging assignments depending on the number of entries.

**Venue Rules:** Please be aware that smoking and chewing gum are not allowed on the show grounds as per the venue rules. Your cooperation in observing these rules is appreciated. Thank you.
