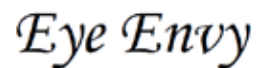

EXHIBITORS MUST PROVIDE A COVERED LITTER TRAY FOR EACH CAT TO AVOID UNNECESSARY ODOURS IN THE HALL.
NO EXHIBIT SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOW PRIOR TO THE CLOSE OF THE SHOW WITHOUT THE PRIOR PERMISSION OF THE SHOW MANAGER.

ALL EXHIBITS MUST HAVE THEIR CLAWS TRIMMED.

SHOW MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHANGE THE JUDGING ASSIGNMENTS DEPENDING ON THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES.

GCCFSA COVID-SAFE GUIDELINES

GCCFSA will:

- Keep an attendance record, including the name, phone number or email address, and date and time of people attending the cat show, for the purpose of contact tracing in relation to COVID-19.
- Maintain and encourage others to maintain the physical distancing principle of at least 1.5 metres separation, where possible:
 - This includes between groups within each room.
 - At entry and exit points.
- Consider venue layout and move tables and seating to comply with physical distancing (1.5m separation) and density requirements (1 person per 2 square metres).
- Dedicate separate entry and exit doors from separate rooms, and pathways to encourage “one-way traffic” where possible.
- Minimise mixing between separate rooms or groups of people as much as possible.
- Display signage at the venue entrance to instruct members of the public (and staff) not to enter if they are unwell or have COVID-19 symptoms.
- Monitor compliance with physical distancing requirements, with particular regard to areas where members of the public might congregate.
- Encourage and support downloading of COVID-Safe App.
- Clean bathrooms more frequently than lower traffic areas, especially taps, door handles and other frequently touched points.
- Provide hand sanitiser on entry and exit of the premises.

Exhibitors will:

- Declare any contact with COVID-19 by completing the COVID-Safe Questionnaire with their entry, including the following statements:
 - They have not had any flu-like symptoms within the last two weeks
 - They have not been overseas or interstate within previous two weeks
 - They have not been in close contact within anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last two weeks
 - They do not feel unwell.
- Practice safe hygiene by making use of the hand sanitiser provided by the show management, throughout the show.
- Practice physical distancing requirements of at least 1.5 metres separation, where possible.
- Maintain physical distancing from judges and stewards at all times.
- Should an exhibitor become unwell with COVID-like symptoms prior to the show, it is important that they do not attend. A refund may be possible.
- Should an exhibitor become unwell with COVID-like symptoms during the show, it is important to advise show management immediately. You may be asked to leave the show hall and a COVID-19 test will be required to ensure the safety of all exhibitors.

*Cosgrove Hall has a COVID-Safe capacity of 300 people, however this will be limited to EXHIBITORS ONLY. Public will not be allowed at this show. The Hall will be set up as a semi-closed show with open judging and a seated area for exhibitors.
