(All cats MUST be entered in their respective Award of Merit or Merit Award classes & all kittens in correct classes (M9, F9, M7, F7, M5, F5) and reduced fees do NOT apply to any compulsory classes. Litters compete in breeds – rest in colour & breed.)

"EASY ENTRY FORMS"

With our summary sheets, you save time when entering several exhibits, and we save time if you complete your Vetting slip.

For exhibits entered in a previous TCC Show with parents listed correctly in that catalogue, Sire & Dam lines may be left blank.

All other information MUST be shown on all forms.

BEST DECORATED CAGE

ENTRY IN THIS CLASS IS FREE – Theme: "Remembrance". Judging - 2.00 P.M. All decorated cages will be judged.

Note: welfare/comfort of exhibits is considered in judging.

JUDGES FANCY: will be awarded to an exhibit selected by each Judge (from any section).

LUCKY CAGE - This replaces "lucky entry form".

LUCKY CATALOGUE (Number on back)

Winning catalogue MUST be shown to claim prize.
